Stories about people dying from inhaling carbon monoxide from faulty gas appliances are sadly all too common. An estimated 20 people a year die in the UK from exposure to this silent killer.

People living in rented accommodation need to know that their landlord has a legal duty to ensure that gas appliances are regularly maintained and that the work is carried out by a Gas Safe registered engineer. This maintenance is vital, and could mean the difference between life and death. Even those people who survive exposure can suffer serious injury, including paralysis and brain damage.
