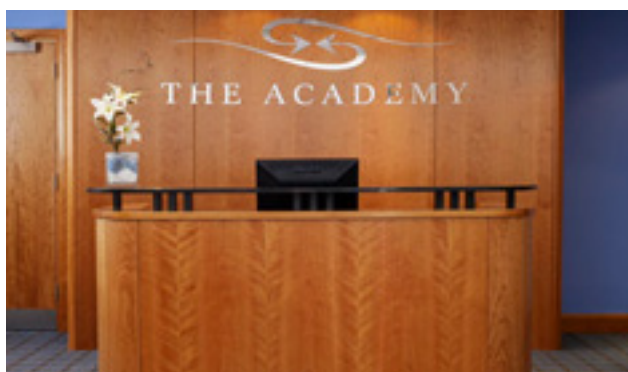


APIL REGIONAL FORUMS 2010
