“How HSE investigates accidents – and how we can help each other”

Speaker:

By John Claxton, Health & Safety Executive

John was born and raised in Norwich [and currently the only Norfolk born HSE Inspector], attended Hewett Grammar School, left Norwich at 18, first degree was in Civil Engineering, worked on the construction of Hartlepool and Heysham Nuclear Power Stations for one year, and then two years on major highway projects. John joined the HSE on the 1st of April 1979.

John obtained a Post Graduate Diploma in Health and Safety - it is a Masters Degree without the thesis. John worked in the Stoke on Trent Office from 1979 to 1987, then transferred to Sheffield Office, and then transferred back to Norwich in 1991. He completed his Law Degree with the College of Law 2000-2004.

John supports Norwich City FC. John has never been one to avoid taking enforcement action or seeking justice. He served the first Prohibition Notice on noise and took the first HSE prosecution for noise and there was a big personal injury claim resulting in this as the person had noise induced hearing loss at 21. John served the first Prohibition Notice on crowd safety, closed Chelmsford Market and appeared in a cartoon in the 'Market Trader' magazine.
