Spectacular views abound with dramatic tee shots over valleys and breathtaking downhill shots. It was the stage for the 2015 Wales Senior Open, the opening event of the EuroPro Tour season.

The APIL charity golf day will take place on the day prior to the clinical negligence conference and golfers are invited to book a place on Wednesday evening's welcome reception which will also open the conference.
